CRITERIA Law Enforcement personnel in good standing; active in the LETR movement, who has passed away since the last LETR International Conference. Submissions should have the review and approval of and be received through the LETR Program Liaison or Director. NOTE: this **does not** have to be an in-the- Line-of-Duty death.

PHOTO REQUIREMENTS: **At least 1 MB minimum per digital photo required;** In order to create the highest quality presentation, Programs should submit only high resolution digital photos in JPG file format.

To achieve the necessary resolution for a sharp image projection on the IMAG screens at the conference at least 1 MB file minimum per digital photo is required. **Photos that have been compressed for emailing are unusable for this project and will not be accepted.** Your assistance in providing digital images that meet the 1 MB minimum file size requirement is much appreciated. Submitted photos should be “semi-close-ups” with a relatively uncluttered background so that the individual is readily recognizable in the photo. **Official department photos are preferred but not required.**
